

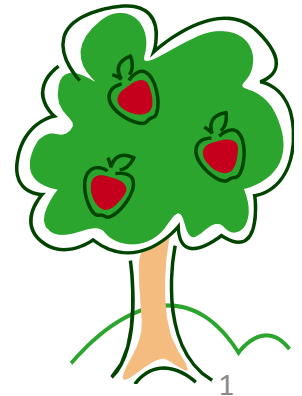

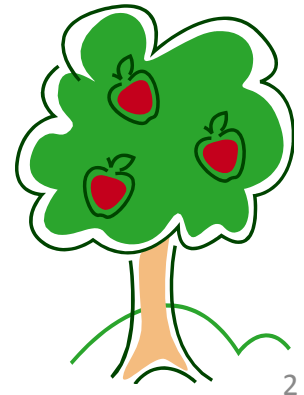

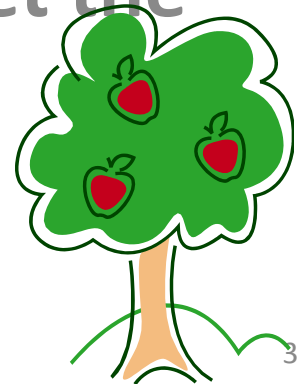
Title One Purpose

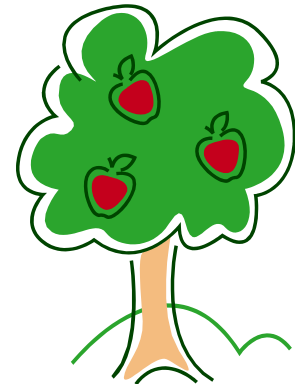
Campfield Early Learning Center

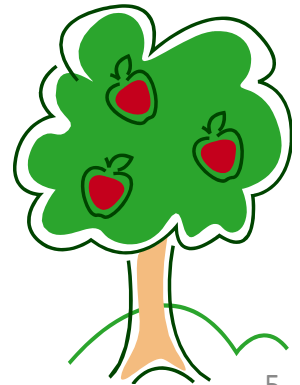

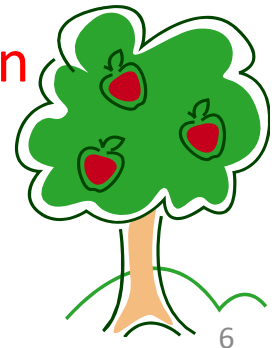

- Notes from teacher, special events, school information



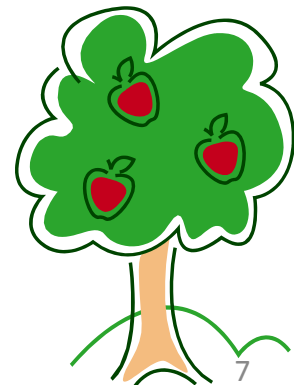
How can you be Involved in your Child's Education at Campfield

- Always ask questions. If you don't understand something. Ask someone for assistance.

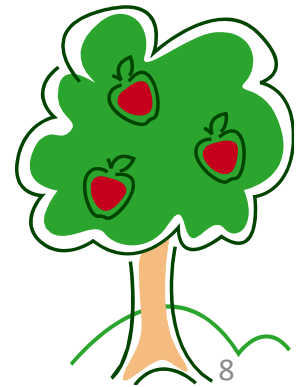
